Morning Carpet Time All child photos are placed in the pocket chart. During "Carpet Time," your child can receive a job or report the current weather. Snack helper of the day is announced to the group. The letter of the week is also introduced, along with alphabet story/puppet time. We review phone numbers, addresses, birthdays and parents names while finger spelling your child's first name in Sign Language.

Constructive Play Your child can discover and explore multiple unit based Learning Centers, theme-related Dramatic Play areas, Library Corner, Art Easel board, and the Computer Station.

Movement • Music • Sign Your child learns sign language skills along with appreciating a variety of music and fun movement activities.

Super Snack Time All wash hands and form a line for snack time in the other classroom. Your child will enjoy a healthy snack while proudly pouring 100% juice or milk into their own cup from the child-size carafe.

Large Motor Play Allows your child to participate in group activities, games, climbing, riding toys, building with blocks and just having wholesome fun.

Story Time • Dismissal Story time builds listening skills and imagination with the use of creative storytelling techniques – reading, using flannel boards and listening to books on tape. "Rexella" the Dinosaur puppet ends the day with a friendly goodbye hug.
